TITANIC CLASSICS

DRY MARTINI

Gin is the original spirit which gives the world its most famous cocktail the DRY MARTINI created in 1911 for the head bartender Martini Di Arma Di Taggia at the Knickerbockers hotel (New York).

Using London dry gin and Nosily Prat vermouth, with a lemon twist.

The olive was added by Knickerbocker regulars.

MANHATTAN

The Manhattan was created in 1874 at Manhattan club (New York) for the lady Jennie Churchill (sir Winston's mother) at the celebration dinner given when William Tilden became state governor. Using the Bourbon, angostura bitter, sweet vermouth to do one cocktail with heartbeat.

SIDECAR

There are plenty of theories when it comes to naming the person who first made this cocktail using this keys ingredients Hennessy Cognac, Cointreau & Lemon Juice but it is generally thought it was created for a military chap in Paris during the first world war, who used to arrive at Henry's New York bar, located in a small side street off a main boulevard, in a chauffeur-driven motorcycle sidecar.

OLD FASHIONED

The first "Old Fashioned" comes from a Bourbon or Rye whiskey, Sugar Cube & Angostura Bitters cocktail was said to have been at the Pendennis Club, a gentleman's club founded in 1881 in Louisville, Kentucky. The recipe was said to have been invented by a bartender at that club in honor of Colonel James E. Pepper

SINGAPORE SLING

There are plenty of theories when it comes to naming the person who first made this cocktail, but the records showed that the real date when the cocktail was created was in 1915 by Ngian Tong boon using Gin, triple sec, D.O.M. Benedictine, cherry brandy, pineapple juice, the bartender of that enduring symbol of British colonialism, Singapore's Raffles hotel.

WHISKEY SOUR

The oldest historical mention of a whiskey sour was published in the Wisconsin newspaper, Waukesha Plain Dealer, in 1870. In 1962, the Universidad del Cuyo published a story, citing the Peruvian newspaper Comercio de Iquique, which indicated that Elliott Stubb created the "whiskey sour" Bourbon Whiskey, Lemon Juice, Sugar Syrup & Egg White in 1872. (El Comercio de Iquique was published by Modesto Molina between 1874 and 1879.) Peruvian newspaper

MOJITO

Havana, Cuba, is the birthplace of the Mojito, although the exact origin of this classic cocktail is the subject of debate. The tale said that Mojito was made by a customer around the 16th century mixing Rum, Fresh Mint, Lime Juice and Soda Water, a drink known as "El Draque", after Sir Francis Drake.

LONG ISLAND ICE TEA

"The world famous Long Island Iced Tea was first invented in 1972 by me, Robert Butt, while I was bartending at the infamous Oak Beach Inn. I participated in a cocktail creating contest. Triple Sec had to be included so I decide to add Vodka, Gin, Tequila, Rum, Lime Juice and Coke, and the bottles started flying. My concoction was an immediate hit and quickly became the house drink at the Oak Beach Inn. By the mid-1970s, every bar on Long Island was serving up this innocent-looking cocktail, and by the 1980s it was known the world over."

COSMOPOLITAN

Though this drink's origin is often-disputed, the most recognized creation of the Cosmo is credited to Toby Cecchini, of The Odeon in Manhattan in 1987. According to Kyle Ford, a rep for Cointreau, he was "introduced to the Cosmopolitan by co-worker Melissa Huffsmith. He put a fresh spin on the known South Beach and San Francisco versions that used Rose's Lime Cordial." His mix used Absolut Citron, Cointreau, cranberry juice, and fresh lime juice. And the modern day Cosmo was born.

NEGRONI

In 1919, at Caffè Casoni (formerly Caffè Giacosa), located on Via de Tornabuoni and now called Caffè Roberto Cavalli. Count Camillo Negroni concocted it by asking the bartender, Fosco Scarselli, to strengthen his favorite cocktail, the Americano, by adding gin to the Sweet Red Vermouth & Campari rather than the normal soda water. The bartender also added an orange garnish rather than the typical lemon garnish of the Americano to signify that it was a different drink.
