### Xanadu Vineworks Chardonnay 2020 - Margaret River, Western Australia

£47

Named in honour of the founder Dr John Lagan originally from Omagh, Northern Ireland. The bouquet of this fresh, fruit driven Chardonnay displays nashi pears and grapefruit characters with underlying hints of oyster shell and oatmeal.

Medium bodied and tightly coiled displayed white fleshed stone fruits and zesty citrus flavours. Minerally/quartz-like characters are complimented by a lovey creamy texture derived from lees stirring whilst in barrel. The vibrant fruit and crisp acidity combine to focus the wine perfectly to a lingering fruit finish. (Org/V)

### Attis 'Las Finas' Albariño 2023 - Rias Baixas, Spain

£52

ATTIS is the consequence of our deep admiration and respect for the vineyard and its terroir. This Albariño, true to its varietal character, combines freshness and complexity thanks to an ageing process on the lees and the contribution of a short stay in oak foudres.

A wine with a lot of personality that will accompany your appetiser to lead you to a meal full of experiences. Enjoy with fish, seafood, creamy cheeses and everything you can imagine. (V)

### Chateau de Fontaine-Audon Sancerre 'Terrior Silex' 2022 - Loire, France

£71

This wine is made from fruit of the flinty soiled vineyards, 'terroir silex', surrounding one of the few châteaux in Sancerre.

Wonderfully fresh and mineral-driven, with intense crisp orchard fruits and beautifully balanced acidity followed by a touch of melon ripeness to the fruit.

### Olivier Zeter Sauvignon Blanc Fumé 2021 - Pfalz, Germany

£76

"A very serious Sauvignon with some honeysuckle and weight but quite enough freshness. Green grassy aromas before the richness imbued by the winemaking kicks in. Very appetising.

When Germany produces a really interesting, well-balanced Sauvignon, you know the wine world is truly changing and we all have to run to keep up. A hint of reduction is encouraged." Jancis Robinson (V)

### Domaine Des Deux Roches Pouilly-Fuisse Vieilles Vignes 2022 - Burgundy, France

£105

This domaine is based in the village of Davayé, in the Mâconnais, and is jointly owned by Jean-Luc Terrier and Christian Collovray. Their 50 hectares of vineyards largely lie between the twin escarpments of Solutré and Vergisson and showcase the diverse terroirs of the region.

Featuring aromas of white-flesh fruits, toasted bread, honey, and hints of vanilla. With a round, rich and unctuous mouthfeel, the wine is balanced by a nice acidity, and a fresh, persistent finish with the flavour of hazelnut (V).

## DIRECTOR'S CHOICE WHITES



### Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard Chablis 1er Cru Vau de Vey 2021 - Burgundy, France

£91

The domaine of Jean-Marc Brocard began as just one hectare, a wedding gift from his wine growing father-in-law. He has since expanded to 200 hectares, of which half are organic or biodynamic, and is widely recognised as one of Chablis's leading producers.

The palate is well balanced with blackcurrant leaf and a touch of spice on the entry, a fine bead of acidity with a poised, and quite energetic finish, a tang of white pepper that lingers on the aftertaste.

"Very fine, but it will need two or three years in bottle." - Neal Martin (Org/V)

### Jean-Luc Colombo Condrieu Amour De Dieu 2018 - Rhone, France

£96

Innovation, passion and dedication are what drives Jean-Luc and Anne Colombo, whose contributions to Rhône Valley winemaking is unparalleled. Viognier grapes from 40-year-old vines are hand-harvested and de-stemmed.

Fermentation in stainless steel tanks to preserve the purity of fruit. Aged 'sur lie' in oak for ten months, rounding out and softening the mouthfeel. Complex nose of apricots, pear, acacia and soft spices accompanied by hints of vanilla.

On the palate, rich, powerful, and aromatic with a long and elegant finish; intense flavours of lychee nut, peach and exotic fruit.

### Tolpuddle Coal River Chardonnay 2022 - Tasmania, Australia

The Tolpuddle Vineyard was purchased by Michael Hill Smith MW and Martin Shaw in 2011 (the founders of the now world-famous, Shaw + Smith). With a brilliant pale-yellow colour, this wine boasts decadent aromas of citrus, white peach, and melon, which are beautifully complemented by subtle notes of French oak.

On the palate, the wine exhibits exceptional flavours of fresh citrus, apple, and pear, which are expertly balanced by delicate mineral undertones and tangy acidity.

The result is a smooth and creamy wine with a long finish that will leave you wanting more. This wine is the epitome of elegance and is perfect for any special occasion.

### Domaine Chanson Meursault 2022- Burgundy, France

£150

Domaine Chanson has been under the Bollinger family's ownership since 1999. They invested in both vineyards and cellar to improve the quality of wines.

Sourced from four vineyards, two are located on mid slopes to add finesse and minerality, the two others around the village to add richness and depth. Aged in oak barrels for 12 months.

Aromas of fleshed fruit, honey and spices with a hint of minerals. Well-structured. Generous and complex on the palate.

### Antinori Cervaro della Sala Chardonnay 2021 - Umbria, Italy

£172

The Antinori family have been producing wine in Tuscany for six centuries, and exporting it for four; that's twenty-six generations of uninterrupted family ownership. This Cervaro della Sala is a luminous straw yellow in colour streaked with occasional greenish highlights.

The nose shows light toasted notes accompanied by aromas of citrus fruit, tropical fruit, and hints of butter. The palate is notably savoury and fresh, with characteristics of chamomile, white fruit, and flint along with a pleasurable persistence and tasting depth.

Its youth, although already inviting and enjoyable, announces much capacity for ageing.

<b>Ontañón Reserva 2015 - Rioja, Spain</b> Bodegas Ontañón is a 5th generation family-owned and run winery in Rioja Baja (now Rioja Oriental). Reservas are only produced in years of exceptional quality - and from the most select vineyards. Aromas of bramble fruit with spice and lightly floral notes.  On the palate plum and blackberry fruit flavours combine with ample acidity, minerality and earthy notes. It has a fine structure, and supple tannins give elegance and length.	£52
<b>Chateau La Fleur Penin St Emilion Grand Cru 2022 - St. Emilion, France</b> The nose is fruity, racy and offers a fine complexity. It reveals notes of wild cassis, blackberry, small notes of small ripe wild black fruits associated with touches of crushed raspberry, small crushed berries, liquorice as well as very discreet hints of sweet spices and a subtle hint of pepper.  On the palate this wine expresses notes of juicy cassis, juicy blackberry and touches of raspberry. Good length and persistence.	£67
<b>Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva 2021 - Tuscany, Italy</b> The Antinori family have been producing wine in Tuscany for six centuries, and exporting it for four; that's twenty-six generations of uninterrupted family ownership. The nose shows notes of ripe red fruit, wild cherries and sensations of dried wild flowers along with spicy aromas of cinnamon and a pleasurable balsamic finish.  The palate is balanced, savoury, and vibrant with a long and persistent aftertaste which brings back the wine's ample spicy aromas and flavours.	£80

### Chateau Tronquoy-Lalande 2012 - St. Estephe, France

£98

Historically the property had a reputation for producing wines with real backbone when young that needed years to come round. In recent years this has changed and new owner Martin Bouyges, who also controls grand cru classé Château Montrose, has accelerated the process of improving the quality of the wine while balancing earlier drinkability with ageworthiness.

The robe is dark red. The nose has an oaky hint and is very well structured with aromas and a touch of spices and mixed fruits. The mouth is fully complex, fruits and spices dominate due to the blending of the petit verdot (11%). It finishes beautifully, with fine and silky tannins.

### Alpha Zeta Amarone Della Valpolicella DOCG 2021 - Veneto, Italy

£101

Selected grapes were picked in mid-September and left to dry in specially ventilated rooms until the end of January. During this time the grapes lost about 40% of their natural weight, concentrating the sugars and flavours - key in producing Amarone's full-bodied, explosive style.

Deep and intense with dried cherries and blueberries, complemented by spiced autumn fruit compote and savoury, cherry fruit character. (V)

## DIRECTOR'S CHOICE REDS

### Prunotto Barolo 2020 - Piedmont, Italy

£107

The Prunotto estate is located in the city of Alba, surrounded by the rolling plains of vines of the Langhe and Roero appellations. They make the most of this advantageous location, producing wines from vines scattered across many of the region's most prestigious areas of the Piedmont region.

The style is modern without being exaggerated: freshness of aroma and approachability of structure are viewed as positives, but copious new oak is not. Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, perfumed yet persistent on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.

### Jean-Luc Colombo Châteauneuf du Pape, Le Bartavelles 2022 - Rhone, France

£112

Innovation, passion and dedication are what drives Jean-Luc and Anne Colombo, whose contributions to Rhône Valley winemaking is unparalleled. "Les Bartavelles" means the Royal Partridges in French.

This wine is from one of the best terroirs in the appellation which has rolled river pebbles which deliver a wine of elegance, richness, and structure. Lovely scents of ripe red fruit, licorice and sweet spice. A powerful and full-bodied wine with rich notes of blueberry, wild herbs and lots of spice.

### Domaine Alain Micholet Nuits St Georges Vieilles Vignes 2019 - Burgundy, France

£140

The origin of the property dates back to around 1880 and four generations of winemakers have contributed to the development of this renowned estate. More recently Alain Michelot, though still in charge, has handed the winemaking reins to his daughter, Elodie, and the wines produced here have gained in finesse and purity as a result.

Displaying all the richness garnered from 45 year old vines. Powerful, aromatic and with wonderful texture this wine offers complex flavours of blackberry, blackcurrant and smoke leading on to a long, elegant and flavoursome finish.

## DIRECTOR'S CHOICE REDS

### Buena Vista Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 - California, USA

£132

Founded in 1857 by the self-proclaimed 'Count of Buena Vista' Agoston Haraszthy, Buena Vista pioneered the production of high-quality wines in California. Following several changes in ownership, the historic winery was purchased in 2011 by the Boisset family from Burgundy. Under Jean-Charles Boisset, the winery has undergone extensive renovation and the Count's original vision is being pursued with renewed vigour.

A polished Napa Valley Cab from Buena Vista, rich, layered and full-bodied with ripe dark plum, black currant, blackberry, meaty, minty and cedar spice flavours on the palate. Smooth with structured tannins and balanced acidity. Love the long and juicy, dark cherry finish.

### Chateau Kirwan 3ème Cru Classé Cru 2017 - Margaux, France

Chateau Kirwan is an estate ranked Third Growth by the prestigious classification system of 1855. A wine that can be consumed either quite young or after plenty of time spent ageing in the bottle, the 2014 vintage of Chateau Kirwan is a great and complex Margaux indeed. The blend consists of 58% Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc and 4% Petit Verdot.

In the glass, this Chateau Kirwan wine from Margaux displays an intense red colour and gives off quite a grand palette of freshly ripened dark berry. The attack in the mouth is bold and vibrant. The mid-palate is fleshy, almost juicy (with plenty of scrumptious fruit present), all upon very elegant, distinguished tannins with a refined grain.

The tannic structure and balance of this wine reveals Cabernet Sauvignon that is perfectly concentrated and gradually ripened. The fruity finish is persistent. This wine is very nicely balanced on the whole. It is indeed a great Margaux classic.

### Sartori Prosecco N.V. - Italy, Veneto

### Langlois Chateau Cement de Loire N.V. - Loire, France

Under the auspices of Bollinger, Langlois has further augmented the regulations to equal, and even exceed, those of Champagne: Vibrant and racy fruit, bread yeast flavours and zesty apple freshness is accompanied by the waxed-lemon flavours of Chenin Blanc - a variety so clearly suited for sparkling production due to its fine acidity. The Chardonnay adds fruitiness and depth.

### Ayala Brut Majeur N.V. - Champagne, France

Brut Majeur perfectly represents the AYALA style. The Chardonnay reveals all of its purity and elegance, enhanced by Pinot Noirs and Meuniers, from the best origins. Expressive notes of citrus, florals and white fruits. Well balanced with a delicate complexity, Chardonnay adds a lively, fresh fruitiness on the palate, whilst Pinot Noir gives the wine richness and length.

### Ayala Blanc de Blancs 2014 / 2018 - Champagne, France

Elaborated in limited quantities, exceptionally during the most expressive years, Le Blanc de Blancs brings to the light all of the elegance and the purity from the Chardonnay of the Côte des Blancs. This terroir is home to the most beautiful Chardonnays with a great ageing potential, including three Grands Crus which form the fundamentals of the blend. Fresh and lively from the get-go, with a broad and appetising palate of white fruit and acacia honey, subtle pastry overtones. The finish is long and persistent, revealing a delicate salinity, along with hints of grapefruit and blood orange.

<b>Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut N.V. - Champagne, France</b> Special Cuvée is the result of the delicate blending between harvest grapes and a majority of Reserve Wines in magnums, including some aged for more than 15 years in Bollinger's cellars. On the nose this has beautiful aromatic complexity, ripe fruit and spicy aromas, hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches. The palate a subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and notes of fresh walnut.	£87	£47
<b>Bollinger La Grand Année 2014 - Champagne, France</b> At Bollinger, only very high quality harvests become a vintage: the exceptional 2014 vintage led to Bollinger creating expressive wines that were simultaneously full, fresh and complex. La Grande Année is the embodiment of the carefully pre-served traditional expertise of the Bollinger Champagne House. The scent is beautifully house typical, dominated by apricot, almond, hazelnut and a smoky sophisticated intensity as from a newly lit outdoor fire. The attack is stunningly intense and the weight in the oral cavity leaves nothing left to wish for. Resilient energy and fullness are combined with greatness.	£300	
<b>Bollinger R.D. 2008 - Champagne, France</b> An old vintage, with a very low dosage, that has been disgorged just prior to release: R.D. is a wine that has always been ahead of its time and embodies Madame Bollinger's visionary spirit. The combination of the long wait during the ageing process and the immediacy of disgorgement enables the harmonious contrast between the different temporalities of R.D. A rich, precise mousse. Citrus notes are followed by flavours of Mirabelle plums and vine peaches. A very vivacious wine which unfolds to reveal exceptional complexity. Notes of fresh hazelnuts and salinity combine to create an intense, everlasting finish.	£450	
<b>Dom Perignon 2013 - Champagne, France</b> A cacophony of scents: smoke, spices, saffron, sweet yellow pepper, mustard seed and rainwater. Very impressive that it should be so vibrant at such a young age. The palate is creamy and dense, yet fresh and precise, with a composed, smooth mousse. The finish is majestic, with earthy, Meursault-like flavours, mineral and charcoal.	£500

The palate has good structure, length, depth and vivacity, with a velvety mousse and lingering flavours of wild berries.
